

St Matthews is open for Mass. Sunday Mass will continue to be streamed on YouTube for those who cannot attend. Mass is open to everyone, not just St Matthew's parishioners. Maximum number of 44 in the congregation. Many thanks to those who have volunteered as stewards/cleaners to make it possible for us to open subject to necessary Government and Diocesan Health and Safety requirements. We could not do it without you.

Weekday Mass will be celebrated on Monday 21st, Tuesday 22nd, Wednesday 23rd, Saturday 26th September at 10am. You do not need to book to attend weekday Mass. **Sunday Mass is at 10am.To attend you MUST BOOK 2** 07513143133. Tues 12-2pm, 6-8pm, Wed 12-2pm, Fri 12-2pm. No text messages please.

The live time of prayer with Deacon Kevin will no longer take place on Sundays. We hope to make an alternative arrangement in the near future.

Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals can now take place. Attendance limited to 30 people.

Jarrow Churches

The following criteria apply in all cases. Please follow the directions of the stewards who are generously giving their time, and are operating in accordance with your parish specific instructions re church capacity/social distancing as issued by Diocesan Health and Safety. A plea to the few who are NOT complying – you are risking the closure of our churches.

- Face coverings/masks are now mandatory in ALL places of worship for all services.
- You will also be asked to provide contact details when attending Mass for Track and Trace purposes.
- Use the hand sanitiser available on entering and leaving.
- please follow strict social distancing. Social distancing spaces are marked out on the benches and in aisles.
- The toilets are closed.
- Mass will be simpler and shorter than normal -no Singing, Bidding Prayers, Offertory Procession, Sign of Peace.
- Communion can only be received in the hand under the form of the Sacred Host.
- If you feel under the weather please do not come to Church.
- You do not need to book to attend weekday Mass, but you must book to attend Sunday Mass.
- The booking telephone number for each parish will be switched off outside booking times, and once booking capacity full. If it is switched off during the scheduled booking slot times it means there are no places left.
- Each week you may only book for the coming Sunday and not for future dates.
- Mass is open to everyone, not only parishioners of the open church

Please remember the Obligation to attend Sunday Mass is suspended at present.

Father Saji and Father Adrian will continue to celebrate Mass privately for churches not yet open for the intentions listed on this newsletter. (If you have already given an intention for the weeks ahead and would prefer to defer it please let us know by e-mail).

If you would like to put in a new Mass intention please send an email to your parish, giving name and preferred date of intention to have a Mass said by Fr Adrian or Fr Saji.
